Sir,
The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has received online application (Part-1) seeking permission for student intake in under graduate course (BHMS) with intake capacity of 50 seats for the academic year 2022-23.

2. As per provision of NCH Act, 2020 Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MA&RBH) has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission for student intake to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that Part-1 proforma and all the relevant documents submitted by your college were examined as per the existing regulations.

3. On scrutiny and careful consideration of the documents and further observations of the Board, the following shortfalls were observed to be addressed for granting permission for student intake in UG (BHMS) for the academic year 2022-23:

A. Hospital Facility:

a) ECG and USG facility not available. House Physician 02 not available.

B. Miscellaneous:

a) Alcohol License not renewed. Application sent for approval to Excise department. Anatomy Act not available.

b) Form-16 not provided from TRACES portal.

C. It is observed that the Inspection fees for the year 2022-23 is not remitted till date. Therefore, you are requested to submit the payment details to the Board within 01 week from the issuance of this letter, otherwise permission stands withdrawn.

D. IPD bed occupancy is found to be 14.79% IPD and attendance of the College need to be tremendously improved since the College is involved in imparting clinical training facilities to the students. College may furnish a compliance report after taking measures within 30 days and affidavit from the controlling authority of the College within 07 days from issue of the letter.

4. After considering the provisions of NCH Act, 2020 and its relevant regulations, **permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is granted to Bengal Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Ismile, Asansol-713301, West-Bengal with intake capacity of 50 seats for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 50 seats for academic session 2022-23.**

5. All admissions in Under Graduate (BHMS) course shall be through 'National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET)' only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% seats of permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy as per rules and the penalty as decided by NCH will be imposed.

6. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State/ UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State / UT. 100% Under Graduate of the permitted intake capacity shall be treated as all India quota for Deemed University as they are All India in nature. The Counseling of seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government.

7. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under. The category wise list of students admitted may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.
